

Class 1 SPV – How to apply – South Australia

This information sheet is a quick reference on how to complete the most common South Australia Class 1 SPV vehicle applications through the NHVR Portal at www.service.nhvr.gov.au

Please note: This list is only a sample of the available configurations and any Class 1 SPV combination can be submitted to the NHVR Portal.

 <p>5 Axle Crane</p>	<p>5 Axle Crane Network – Permit required (network access will be dependant on vehicle dimensions)</p>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 11. Select Network and select SA 12. Click Next to Attachments 13. Attached ‘Certificate of Approval for Road Travel’ from DPII, any clearance letters or supporting documentation
