- Collect relevant documents and forms for submission.
- Be able to make payment at the time of submitting your application.

If you remove a vehicle from your vehicle list you will be required to:

- Submit this form within 14 days of removing the labels.

If you are adding vehicles to maintenance you will need to:

- Provide proof of vehicle roadworthiness.
